The equipment listed and described herein is the property of TES:

1. A wooden St Andrews Cross, made of 150mm x 50 mm and 100 mm x 50 mm dressed timber, each arm 2530 mm long diagonally, on a base 1225 mm by 1310 mm, painted black with red vinyl padding.



2. A rectangular wooden suspension frame, made of 100 mm x 50 mm dressed timber bolted together, 2340 mm high on a base 1200 mm x 1220 mm, with three loose floor boards, painted black.



3. A steel cage with three sides, a top and three opening doors on the front, 2000 mm high x 1000 mm deep x 680 mm wide, bolted to a plywood base 1200 mm x 1770 mm, painted black.



4. A wooden kneeling frame, 1030 mm long x 910 mm wide.



5. A massage table, 1800 mm long x 700 mm wide.



- 6. A hinged wooden head box, painted black (no picture).
- 7. A wooden pillory, unpainted, as per photograph.



8. A box of tools and bolts associated with the equipment.
